More recently, while serving as the Managing Director of the NYPSC's Offices of Accounting & Finance, Regulatory Economics, Energy Efficiency and the Environment, and Electric Gas & Water, Mr. Stewart was a senior technical and policy advisor to the Commission. He has an M.B.A. in Corporate Finance from the State University of New York at Albany and a B.S. in Business Management from St. John Fisher College.
