Ms. Nelson has also supported expert witness testimony development and performed analysis on topics including revenue requirements, capitalized interest, the appropriate level of remuneration for long-term renewable power contracts, resource planning prudence issues, and buy side due diligence. Ms. Nelson's career highlights include serving as a former staff economist at the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities and a petroleum economist for the State of Alaska, where she managed the state's biannual oil and natural gas revenue forecast, and was responsible for the production forecast.
