He is a testifying expert on utility finance matters, and has filed expert testimony on cost of capital before regulatory commissions throughout Canada and the U.S. Mr. Trogonoski has also supported several mergers and acquisitions by providing due diligence and developing testimony in support of the financial aspects of the proposed transaction before state regulators.

Some of Mr. Trogonoski's notable utility consulting work with Concentric includes filing expert testimony on behalf of Canadian utilities, including the recent generic cost of capital proceedings in Ontario and Alberta. Mr. Trogonoski was an industry leader in recommending the use of a North American proxy group (consisting of both Canadian and U.S. utilities) to estimate the cost of equity for a Canadian utility company.
